HOW TO ORDER Flexischools ordering

Lunch orders can be placed via Flexischools before 9.00am on the day at www.flexischools.com.au, or download the app for your phone.

Sushi-Mondays Only. Sushi orders can be placed via Flexischools or by paper bag on Mondays.

Please note Flexischools MFAL DFALS can only be ordered via Flexischools. They are not available with cash orders.

Paper bag and cash ordering

Alternatively a paper bag order can be placed in canteen cash order box by 9.00am on the day. The child's name and class must be clearly written on the paper bag.

It's best to use the exact money, but change can be given if required.



- Please no staples, sticky tape, or mini plastic bags with paper bag orders. These slow down the Volunteers and often the bags get damaged by staples/sticky tape and have to be replaced.
- Paper lunch bags are available from supermarkets, 100 for \$2.00.
- You can also buy paper bags from the Canteen, 10 for \$0.30

The current menu and pricing is available at the Canteen, from the Office or on the Winston Heights Public School app.

NO LUNCH?

If a student has no recess/lunch from home or a Canteen order, they can still get something to eat.

Students are to see their classroom teacher and then they will be sent to the Office. The Office will provide a recess/lunch Request Form that the student can bring to the Canteen.

An invoice will then be sent home for this order. Prompt payment of this invoice is greatly appreciated.

MEAL DEALS

Please note Flexischools MEAL DEALS can only be ordered via Flexischools, they are not available with cash orders.

These MEAL DEALS encourage healthy Everyday choices and give a discount of \$0.30 per order.

The Canteen aims to keep its prices low, but at times suppliers costs increase and often we need to pass these on. The cost of fresh fruit and vegetables has also increased in the past year and some of these costs are also passed on.
