It has been a delight to meet some parents and carers at the school gates and I look forward to getting to know many more families over the coming weeks and months.

Weekly Assemblies

As Department of Education COVID guidelines evolve, we are starting to review the operation of some school activities.

Last term, weekly assemblies were pre-recorded and shared with our community, as students were not able to congregate for short gatherings.

This term, we are able to hold outdoor gatherings of up to 15minutes. As such, commencing this week, we have decided to have outdoor assemblies which will enable students to be presented with certificates in front of their peers.

Our K-2 students will gather every Thursday for a short assembly where they will be presented with class, Principal and special awards. Our 3-6 students will have a quick assembly every Friday.

As COVID guidelines are updated, we will continue to review school operations and make changes as required.

End of Year Presentation Assemblies

Our end of year presentation assemblies will look a little different this year. We are currently reviewing COVID guidelines and making decisions around the organisation for our end of year assemblies. We will keep you informed of the organisation, dates and times of the assemblies in a future newsletter.

2021 School Organisation

We have started looking at school organisation and class formation for 2021.

As student enrolment numbers dictate our staffing allocation and class structure, I encourage any family who may be leaving WHPS at the end of this year to contact the office asap.

Similarly, if you know of any families in our school catchment area who are yet to enrol their child for Kindergarten next year, could you please ask them to do so at their earlier convenience.

Changes to Start of School dates for 2021

Earlier this week, we were notified that there will be two School Development Days (SDD) at the commencement of Term 1 2021. Previously there has only been one SDD at the start of Term 1. The SDD for next year are scheduled for the 27th and 28th January, with students in Year 1 to 6 returning to school on Friday 29 January. Kindergarten students will have their first day of school on Wednesday 3rd February.

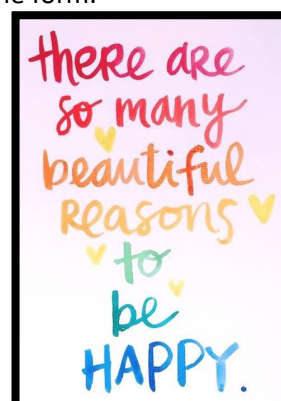


Messages from The Office

The silver lining to this cloud is that there are also a lot of wonderful resources to help us to build our children's resilience, optimism and ability to cope with hard things that happen and troublesome thoughts about what might happen, (I shared some with you in the last newsletter). Here is another beauty. As soon as I saw the resource below, I could not wait to share it with you. It's based on one of my favourite children's books, Mr Jitters, by Kerry Moss, which some kids have already enjoyed with me. This video even has Kerry Moss in it. Selective high schools help these students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, and by using specialised teaching methods.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 11 March 2021.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2022, you need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available in late September 2020 at <https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7>.

The application website opens at that link on 6 October 2020 and closes on 9 November 2020. You must apply before the closing date.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Team for assistance after 6 October 2020.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

School Travel for 2021

2021 school travel applications are now open

Applications for student travel in 2021 opened from Monday 12 October 2020.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now [apply](#) online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who have changed school/campus, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should [re-apply or update their details](#).

*Applications must be completed by the student's parent or legal guardian if the student is aged under 16 years. Students 16 years and over must complete the application form themselves.

Where there is a change of distance eligibility based on a student's grade, the system will automatically update a student's entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new [eligibility criteria](#), they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

[Term Bus Pass](#) holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If a student needs to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to <https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails>

Applications need to be submitted before **31 December 2020** to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2021.

Students residing in Rural and Regional (R&R) areas should receive their travel pass at the commencement of the new school year from their nominated operator, this may be distributed via the school or sent direct to their address. Note: some R&R operators do not issue travel passes. Students/Parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

New Concession Entitlement Cards

Transport for NSW will be replacing the below cards with Transport Concession Entitlement Cards (TCEC) from October 2020:

- 🕒 Senior Secondary Student Concession Card (16 years and over) – also used by Mature Secondary Students (18 years and over), Distance Education Students and Home School Students
- 🕒 Proof of Age card (when a student under 16 years of age looks older)
- 🕒 Boarder Rail Pass.

All previous cards will be valid until they expire. Students who require a Transport Concession Entitlement Card should speak with their school administration staff.
