Dear Parents,

COVID-19 and Changes at School

I would like to take this opportunity to thank parents and carers for remaining calm during these difficult circumstances that we all find ourselves in. It is extremely important to read the letters coming home so you are fully aware of what is happening with regards to school and operations. Whilst we have had to cancel or modify many activities and events at school, we are continuing to run school as close to normal routines as possible. The children remain happy and are continuing their learning.

Staff are planning modified lessons and activities that can be completed at home should schools be told to close. In the meantime teachers are teaching their regular lessons to children who are at school. If parents decide to keep their children at home they should ensure they keep their children learning by providing them with suitable activities for their ability. In yesterday's update letter I spoke about what parents should be using for lessons. NSW Health's recommendation to the Government is that schools remain open. We have hand sanitizers in every room and students are washing their hands regularly. All bathrooms have soap and are checked regularly to ensure they are stocked. Talking to your children about their own hygiene is extremely important.

Today a letter will go home with all students regarding Google Classroom and how to access this from home. Students in Years 3-6 are familiar with this platform already. To access this, students will need to know their Department of Education login details. K-2 students will receive a copy of theirs today so that parents are able to assist with this should students need to learn from home.

Canteen

The Canteen Committee have received some interesting questions recently. Here are the answers.

Q - "What happens when a child comes to the canteen with no lunch order or can't find their lunch order?" A – If a student has no recess or lunch from home or a lunch order, they can still get something to eat. Students let their class teacher know who then send them to the office. The office will provide a recess/lunch Request Form that the student can then take to the canteen. The volunteers will make up a basic sandwich (jam, vegemite, honey or cheese) for lunch. For recess they can have either a pikelet, raisin toast, fresh or frozen fruit. An invoice will be sent home with the child and prompt payment of this would be appreciated.

Q – "What happens when a parent calls in realising their child does not have lunch?" A – The canteen will provide a basic sandwich for the child and an invoice will be sent home and prompt payment is appreciated. The Canteen does not offer any cooked food or drinks for phone orders.

Q- "What if my child does not receive their lunch order?" A – If a child has not received their lunch order, they are also asked to see their classroom teacher and then they will be sent to the office. The volunteers will try to find out what may have gone wrong. If the lunch order was on FlexiSchools this is easier to track than a cash order. The order may have been put in the wrong basket or may not have had the student's name on it. Most times the problem is sorted, but if not, the volunteers can still make up a sandwich for the student.

Thank you to our Canteen volunteers for giving of your time to provide a service to our students.

Harmony Day

It was great to see the children dressed in National Dress or wearing orange for Harmony Day yesterday. While we couldn't have our Parade of Nations the children still discussed Harmony Day and what it means. The students have also been hard at work painting their rocks to place in the "Everyone Belongs" path that will be laid soon. A special thank you to the mum who answered our call yesterday and came in today to assist with planting. The garden is looking great.


Winter Uniforms




News from our Library

Students will need to use their **@education.nsw.gov.au** student email address to register on their first visit. To register, click on the "Sign In" link at the top of the page and then click on the REGISTER button. A verification email will be sent to your child's DEC email address. To complete the registration please click the link provided in the email.

Note: Individual students are eligible for one download per application only.

Please be aware that you must activate the product key within one month, otherwise it will expire. To extend this the activation, you will be required to pay a fee of approximately \$11 to reactivate the product key.

Hi Friends,



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GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Google Classroom is linked to the Department of Education's student portal. It is an online platform that can be used by teachers to support student learning in the classroom and during periods when students need to work from home. Students in Years 3-6 have been using this program at school and for homework. Our younger students will be starting to use this program as well but will require assistance through adult support at home.

All NSW Public school students have access to a google email address. You will need this email to access your child's google account.

Your child's email address is:

@education.nsw.gov.gu

This email address allows students to access all the Google Suite applications.

HOW TO OPEN GOOGLE CLASSROOM

- 1. Open up a browser on the google homepage. (Google Chrome works better for this)
- 2. Click on the Sign in button

(note: if you already have a google account active on that computer you will need to drop the menu and select add another account)


Enter your child's email address as listed above and 3. select NEXT

4. You will then be prompted to the Department's log in page. Enter your child's user name, this is the first part of their email. e.g. first.lastname (s/he may need to include a number if your child has one in their email) and password. Your child's password is specific to them. Years 3-6 set their own, whereas K-2 will be given a password.



5. It may ask you to confirm your address. Click 'Accept'.

- 6. Select log in and confirm
- 7. Now you will return to the google home screen. In the top right-hand corner, you will now see a coloured letter. This will be the letter of you child's first name and indicates that you are in their account.
- 8. Click on the apps button (this is the icon with 9 small squares) and select classroom.



9. In the top right corner, you will see an arrow prompting you to join a class (+). It will then ask you for a class code – a short series of characters. This will only be required the first time the class is joined each year.



<u>Please Note:</u> The Google Classrooms are not setup yet. We will notify you if/when the time comes that we move to **Learning at Home**. Please keep your child's username and password in a secure place for accessing the student portal at all times.

10. Within this classroom you can navigate to see messages, classwork and students.

Use the tabs on the top of the screen to explore work and messages from teachers.

Now you can **complete work, turn it in and post messages and responses** to the classroom teacher. <u>Please note</u> that we discourage students from using this platform as a forum for social chat, it is rather used as a learning tool. We appreciate parents support with this.

This account should remain active on your computer even after you close it down. By going through Google, your log in should be available when you click sign in and you should not need to complete these steps every time.
